NO MORE YouTube ADS!



Eliminate distractions from YouTube! YouTube can be a powerful tool for teaching and learning, but using it in the classroom can be a bit of a gamble, with ads popping up and distracting video suggestions lining the page.

Adding a simple hyphen to the Youtube link, so that youtube appears as yout-ube, solves this problem, allowing students to view content on the site without interruptions.


